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for the chinese the drive toward growing political and economic power is part of an ongoing effort to restore china s past greatness and remove the lingering memories of history s humiliations this widely praised book explores the 1500 1800 period before china s decline when the country was viewed as a leading world culture and power europe by contrast was in the early stages of emerging from provincial to international status

while the united states was still an uncharted wilderness d e mungello argues that this earlier era ironically may contain more relevance for today than the more recent past this fully revised fourth edition retains the clear and concise quality of its predecessors while drawing on a wealth of new research on sino western history and the increasing contributions of chinese historians building on the author s decades of research and teaching this compelling book illustrates the vital importance of history to readers trying to understand china s renewed rise china s renewed rise china s renewed rise

students of western civilization need more than facts they need to understand the cross cultural global exchanges that shaped western history to be able to draw connections between the social cultural political economic and intellectual happenings in a given era and to see the west not as a fixed region but a living evolving construct these needs have long been central to the making of the west the book s chronological narrative emphasizes the wide variety of peoples and cultures that created western civilization and places them together in a common context enabling students to witness the unfolding of western history understand change over time and recognize fundamental relationships

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for too long the history of contract between china and the west has been portrayed as a one sided encounter europeans were said to have discovered china while chinese responses to the west went largely unnoticed

this volume brings together an interdisciplinary team of established and emerging scholars from the disciplines of history political science and

communication studies to provide a historical reappraisal of cambodia s relationships with the west contributors to the volume examine moments of historical import in cambodia s history from the sixteenth to the twenty first century these include cambodia s first contacts with european mercantilism the establishment of formal french colonialism and commercialism british peace enforcement and diplomacy after the second world war independence modernisation and the onset of the cold war and the united nations peace process and the khmer rouge genocide tribunal of more recent times the result is a unique and significant new analysis of some of cambodia s most controversial interactions with the west demonstrating how far the west has shaped the development of cambodia in the contemporary epoch

the west and china since 1500 surveys western relations with and attitudes towards china since sustained contact and desirable trading began with the great alternative culture in the sixteenth century the experiences of traders diplomats and missionaries are surveyed and illustrated by frequent quotations from contemporary sources in addition the book explores the flow of cultural influences in both directions and changes in western opinion about china from admired model to disdained land of the eternal standstill to feared resurgent power finally the author examines current issues in dispute such as taiwan and human rights

this is a new edition of geoffrey parker s much admired illustrated account of how the west so small and so deficient in natural resources in 1500 had by 1800 come to control over one third of the world parker argues that the rapid development of military practice in the west constituted a military revolution which gave westerners an insurmountable advantage over the peoples of other continents this edition incorporates new material including a substantial afterword which summarises the debate which developed after the book s first publication
